

To all whom it may concern:

Be it known that I, Clara L. Mead, a citizen of the United States, residing at Rahway, in the county of Union and State of New Jersey, have invented a new, original, and ornamental Design for a Paper Sheet or Similar Article, of which the following is a specification, reference being had to the accompanying drawing, forming part thereof.

The figure is a plan view of a paper sheet

showing my new design.

The design is a number of specters or ghostly figures shrouded and with death's heads, each provided with a jack o' lantern.

Behind said specters or ghosts is a fence, along which cats are walking, and there are trees in which owls are perched. The sky is of contrasted color with the fence, preferably red, as indicated, and the trees, cats and owls are silhouetted against it.
